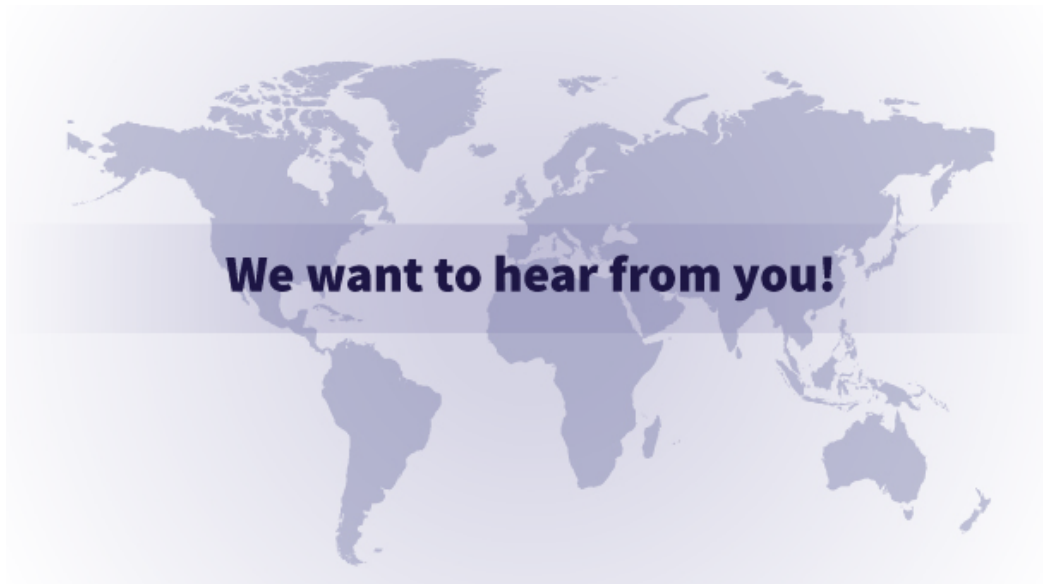




Introducing in 2019
